The Connecticut Food Bank (CFB) is a nonprofit organization, based in East Haven, Connecticut which works with retailers and growers to coordinate the distribution of food to vulnerable demographics. In 2014 it distributed more than 17 million meals across the state. CFB has 700 local "partner programs" (such as soup kitchens, food pantries, shelters and low-income adults) in six counties and more than 4,500 volunteers and staff people. Connecticut Food Bank serves 127 cities and towns. President and CEO is Rob Levine. CFB is part of the Commodity Supplemental Food Program.
